This will be a four-year program with three residents per year.

We also have didactic teaching to cover the full breadth of obstetrics and gynecology, in addition to subspecialty lectures. Included in our weekly didactic teachings are our monthly Journal Club and Morbidity and Mortality conferences and simulation labs.

About the Program

Resident salaries are increasing by 1.5% for all residents in Academic Year 22-23. A review of comparable programs located within the same regions as HCA GME revealed a slight discrepancy across PGY1-PGY7 resident salaries. The salary increase brings the HCA resident salaries in line with the noted reference points. \$950 for on-call meals will be allotted to each resident. New residents and fellows receive up to \$500 for orientation (if it takes place before the official employment date).

About Summerville Medical Center and Trident Health

Summerville Medical Center is a 124-bed, acute care hospital serving families across Charleston, South Carolina for almost 30 years. The hospital has a 24-hour emergency room, including a dedicated ER for children, a wide range of surgical services, and comprehensive medical services. Summerville Medical Center is recognized for its emergency, cardiac, imaging, women's and pediatric, orthopedic, and stroke services for the growing Lowcountry community.

In recent years, Summerville Medical Center has invested more than \$100 million in growing the hospital's women's and pediatric care so that families can receive high quality care close to home, including:

- In 2018 opened a new women's and neonatal tower that includes 30 postpartum private rooms, 12 labor and delivery rooms, 16-bed Level II Special Care Nursery, and more than \$10 million in state-of-the-art technology
- A roster of board-certified, fellowship-trained physicians specializing in women's care
- The only Lowcountry hospital offering NICView, which gives new parents the peace of mind and bonding opportunity to watch their baby while in the Level II Special Care Nursery through a 24/7 secure portal. Each private patient room also features 55" HD Apple TVs and MyCare board technology that combines important patient medical information and streaming entertainment on one TV; wireless fetal monitoring so mom can walk and shower while laboring; HUGS baby safety program; and iMobile staff smartphones that provides instant access to patient vitals and other information for the quality and safety of patient care

- In 2019, Trident Health system consolidated all obstetric and neonatal care to one location at Summerville Medical Center
- High risk obstetric Maternal Fetal Medicine Clinic
- Comprehensive breast health care at the Summerville Breast Center
- Comprehensive urogynecology and pelvic floor care
- Pediatric care includes a 10-bed pediatric ER, inpatient pediatric unit and pediatric intensive care unit, and pediatric subspecialty programs including general surgery, orthopedics, and gastroenterology

In the last year, Summerville Medical Center delivered more than 2,700 babies, including 36 sets of twins, and cared for more than 400 babies in the hospital's Level II Special Care Nursery.

Providing high quality care and an excellent experience for moms and babies is the top priority for the women's and children's team. Families are offered special touches to celebrate the occasion with a celebratory meal for mom and partner, including sparkling grape juice in champagne flutes, a high-end bath robe for mom, and a special "raised on sweet tea and sunshine" for their little one. Special Care Nursery babies also receive a special "Graduate" onesie when they go home.

Summerville Medical Center is part of the Trident Health system, which also includes Trident Medical Center, Brighton Park Emergency, Centre Point Emergency and Moncks Corner Medical Center. Trident Health has earned recognition as a leader in the delivery of healthcare in South Carolina's Lowcountry.
